How the amounts are made up

- Gross: this includes the KOB top-up of € € 25.12, but not the monthly amount for holiday allowance. The holiday allowance is paid in May.
- Tax and national insurance contributions: the amounts are shown after deduction of tax credit as well as without deduction of tax credit. The amounts without deduction of tax credit apply if tax credit is deducted from other income.
- Zvw contribution: this amount is 5.4% of the gross AOW pension.
- Net: this is the amount that we pay you each month.
